In accordance with the terms of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA), the U. S. Department of Energy is notifying the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) and the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) of the Sixth Phase II Field Start for the Steel Creek Integrator Operable Unit (IOU). The Field Start was met on June 25, 2019 ahead of the July 30, 2019 FFA milestone date, initiating deployment of diffusive gradients in thin film (DGT) samplers that will be deployed at several stream locations including within the Steel Creek IOU.
