1. Section 1.0, Summary, page 7. Sentence 2 in paragraph 2 states "All Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) was removed and properly disposed of...". The second sentence of the last paragraph of Section 2.1, Facility Description states "All Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) shall be removed and properly disposed of...". The sentence in section 2.1, Facility Description should be revised to indicate that ACM removal was indeed performed for these refrigeration buildings.
