The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 4 (EPA), has reviewed the K-Area Burning/Rubble Pit and Rubble Pile (131-K and 631-20G) (KBRP), L-Area Burning/Rubble Pit and Rubble Pile (131-L, 131-3L, and 131-2L) (LBRP), and P-Area Burning/Rubble Pit (131-P) (PBRP) Operable Units (OUs) Detailed Combined Groundwater Monitoring Report, CERCLIS Numbers: 40, 56, 59, SRNS-RP-2017-00356, Revision 0, June 2017, and Request to Designate LBRP OU as a No Action OU. EPA comments on the Revision 0 document have been adequately addressed. EPA hereby approves the subject document.

In addition, EPA agreed on October 3, 2017 that monitoring and reporting at the LBRP OU should be discontinued based on long-term groundwater monitoring results. Therefore, EPA agrees that LBRP OU should be designated as a No Action OU.
