The Department has completed its review of the above reference document pursuant to the Savannah River Federal Facility Agreement. Based on this review, the following comment was generated. Due to the nature of this comment, the Department is confident that the necessary changes can be made to the final clean copy version with resolution. Therefore, the above referenced Revision 1 is conditionally approved providing the following comment is addressed and incorporated:

1. Section 3.1.2.2, CSSLP (631-2G), Page 30. The last paragraph of this section references Figure 2 as identifying the location of Carolina Bay #125. Figure 2 in the document shows the location of N Area only. Figure ES-2, page ES-9, identifies the 'Unnamed Carolina Bay' and should indicate the location of Carolina Bay #125. The text needs to reflect the correct figure number in Section 3.1.2.2, the location of Carolina Bay #125 in the Executive Summary, and the correct figure in Appendix A.
