The U. S. Department of Energy is submitting the subject information for your review and approval. The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) and U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provided comments on the Decommissioning Project Final Report (DPFR) for Building 704-7D, D-Area Maintenance Building (V-PCOR-D-00064, Revision 0, July 12, 2021) on October 22, 2021 and January 4, 2022, respectively. The Savannah River Site (SRS) submitted the responses to the regulatory comments on the DPFR on February 24, 2022. In their letter dated March 28, 2022, the EPA approved the responses to their comments. In their letter dated March 28, 2022, the SCDHEC requested a meeting to discuss the response to their comment on the DPFR for Building 704-7D. The comment resolution conference call was held on April 21, 2022. On May 2, 2022, SRS submitted the draft revised DPFR and draft revised comment response to SCDHEC and EPA for review prior to finalizing them for submittal for official approval. On May 2, 2022, EPA replied that the comment response and DPFR revisions were acceptable. On May 13, 2022, SCDHEC replied that the comment response was acceptable and requested one additional revision to Section 7.0 of the DPFR. The enclosures incorporate all requested changes.
