Dear Mr. Hennessey:

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) has reviewed the referenced letter requesting approval for the continued usage of Type I Tank 4F for which the Bulk Waste Removal Efforts (BWRE) milestone has previously been completed. As agreed upon in the *Dispute Resolution Agreement for Alleged Violations of Class 3 Industrial Solid Waste Landfill Permit Facility*, paragraph 17, the Department approves the usage of Tank 4F to store dissolved salt solution originating from Tank 37H. The usage of this tank should not result in any appreciable accumulation of additional solids within Tank 4F as a result of this approval.

Should the Department of Energy propose further usage of Tank 4F or any other tank for which BWRE has been completed, an additional request and justification will need to be submitted to the Department for review and consideration.
