Per regulatory agreement, the Savannah River Site is required to notify the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control when the M-Area Inactive Process Sewer Line (MIPSL) Soil Vapor Extraction Unit (SVEU) is inoperable for more than seven (7) consecutive days. This e-mail serves as notification that the MIPSLE SVE unit has been out of service since August 8, 2019 due to ongoing maintenance work at the M-1 Air Stripper and the planned characterization soil sampling at the operable unit. Currently, the SVEU is scheduled to be out of service until September 19, 2019. A follow-up e-mail will be sent to notify you when the MIPSL SVE unit resumes operation.
