Dear Mr. Hennessey:

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) has reviewed the referenced letter requesting approval for the continued usage of Type I Tanks 10H and 11H for which the Bulk Waste Removal Efforts (BWRE) milestone has previously been completed. The reuse of Tanks 10H and 11H is to support the processing of Tank 9H dissolved salt solution through TCCR Unit 1. The usage of these tanks should not result in any appreciable accumulation of additional solids within Tanks 10H and 11H as a result of this approval.

Should the Department of Energy propose further usage of Tanks 10H and 11H or any other tank for which BWRE has been completed, an additional request and justification will need to be submitted to the Department for review and consideration.
