Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) of the Fourth Phase II Field Start for the Savannah River and Floodplain Swamp Integrator Operable Unit (Including Beaver Dam Creek [NBN]). The Field Start was met on September 27, 2017 with collection of off-site deer foreleg samples to support strontium-90 background data gaps identified in Periodic Report 4 for the Savannah River and Floodplain Swamp Integrator Operable Unit (SRNS-RP-2016-00541, Revision 1, June 2017).
