SUBJECT: Notification of the Removal Action Start Date for the C-Area Groundwater Operable Unit, SEMS Number: 82

In accordance with the terms of the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA), the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is notifying the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) that the Removal Action Start for the C-Area Groundwater (CAGW) Operable Unit (OU) was met on November 19, 2018, ahead of the FFA milestone date of January 30, 2019. The removal action start date was met with the subcontractor's installation of one of the three groundwater monitoring wells. The new monitoring wells are being installed to establish baseline conditions downgradient from the injection well locations as part of the CAGW OU preferred removal action: Treatment Barrier Using Emulsified Edible Oil.
