The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) has reviewed the referenced document with respect to the Memorandum of Agreement for Achieving an Accelerated Cleanup Vision for the Savannah River Site (SRS). The Department agrees that the facility remnants should be added to the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) Appendix K.2, D&D Facilities (or remnants) that Require No Further Evaluation.

The Department has the following comment for future, general reference.


In our comments on the *Deactivation and Decommissioning (D&D) Core Team Protocol for Review and Concurrence on Facility Decommissioning Evaluations and Decommissioning Project Final Reports (ERD-EN-2016-0029, Revision 0 DRAFT, April 2017)*, General Comment # 1, in part, stated the following.

Please apply the phrase, "with the goal of obtaining" to all the stated regulatory review time frames. When the SRS D&D Program began, SCDHEC agreed to the specified regulatory review time frames with the caveat that the Agency would, in good faith, try and meet the time frames but there was no guarantee.

SRS subsequently incorporated the phrase "with the goal of responding" (to document submissions) in the *Core Team Protocol for Review and Concurrence on Facility Decommissioning Evaluations and Decommissioning Project Final Reports SRNS-RP-2021-00120 Revision 0 (corrected) February 2021*. Please ensure that future DPFR and Facility Decommissioning Evaluation (FDE) cover letters utilize the relevant verbiage outlined in the D&D Core Team Protocol.
