Subject: NOTIFICATION OF THE OPERATIONAL STATUS OF THE M-AREA INACTIVE PROCESS SEWER LINE (MIPSL) SVE UNIT

Per regulatory agreement, the Savannah River Site is notifying the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control that the M-Area Inactive Process Sewer Line Soil (MIPSL) soil vapor extraction unit (SVEU) has been inoperable since March 6, 2018 due to the lockout of the M-1 Air Stripper. The MIPSL SVEU will remain out of service until the power source to the M-1 Air Stripper is placed back into service, which is anticipated to be early April 2018. Electrical power for the MIPSL SVEU originates from the same circuit as the M-1 Air Stripper. The M-1 Air Stripper is currently down (outage) to allow the tie-in of new recovery well RWM018, which is being added as part of the M-Area Hazardous Waste Management Facility RCRA corrective action. A follow-up e-mail will be sent to notify you when the MIPSL SVEU resumes operation.
