Continued Usage of High-Level Waste Tank 11H, CERCLIS Number: 89 (dated November 6, 2017).

Dear Mr. Hennessey:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the referenced letter requesting approval for the continued usage of Type I Tank 11H for which the Bulk Waste Removal Efforts (BWRE) milestone has previously been completed.

EPA approves the usage of Tank 11H to support the Tank Closure Cesium Removal (TCCR) – Tank 10H Waste Removal Project (TCCR Unit 1). The usage of this tank is for “additional liquids only (i.e. no appreciable solids)” within Tank 11H as a result of this approval.
