In accordance with the procedures outlined in the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA), this letter serves to inform you that South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) agrees that bulk waste removal (BWR) efforts for Tank 10H have been completed. This decision is based upon the information presented to the Department on October 28, 2019, in a meeting held for the purpose of informing SCDHEC and EPA of completion of BWR efforts for Tank 10H. The Department acknowledges that completion of BWR efforts in this tank will satisfy the commitments for Item 5 listed in Appendix L of the FFA and as modified in the *2018 Update to the Statement of Resolution of Dispute Concerning Extension of Closure Dates for Savannah River Site High-Level Radioactive Waste Tanks 19 and 18 (signed 11/19/07)*.
