The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received the Department of Energy, Savannah River Site Responses to EPA Comments for the Treatability Study Work Plan for Groundwater Injection and Discharge Canal Treatment at the D-Area Groundwater Operable Unit, Redline Revision 1, on June 3, 2019 via email correspondence inclusive of several iterations of email comments and a May 9, 2019 teleconference that led to resolution of outstanding comments.

EPA provides conditional approval of the above mentioned document and comment responses with the understanding that all redline revisions in the above mentioned document are incorporated into the Final Revision, Clean Copy to be submitted, in the near future. The Final Revision, Clean Copy should also use the term "metal cladding" instead of "metal scaling" to describe the potential interaction as acidic water flows over the constructed carbonate reactive barriers during the treatability study timeframe.
