The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed the Effectiveness Monitoring (EM) Report for the Monitored Natural Attenuation (MNA) at the Chemicals, Metals, and Pesticides (CMP) Pits Operable Unit March 2018 through March 2019 (SRNS-RP-2019-00274, Revision 0, June 2019). Based on the review of the document, the Operable Unit (OU) 24 for Calendar Year 2018-2019 documents that the monitoring systems are *installed and operational* for the MNA remedy selected for OU-24.

The EM Groundwater Report also documents the progress of the remedy in reaching the remedial goals. Based on the review of this 2019 Report, the report is approved as documenting the Remedial Action Completion for the MNA remedy for OU-24 at the Savannah River Site.
