Attached for your review is the *Core Team Protocol for Review and Concurrence on Facility Decommissioning Evaluations and Decommissioning Project Final Reports* (SRNS-RP-2021-00120, Revision 1 Redline, August 2022). As stated in the Savannah River Site's (SRS) responses to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency's (USEPA) comments on various D-Area Decommissioning Project Final Reports (DPFRs) (refer to ARF-023598_Clarification Re Protocol.pdf), the subject protocol was revised to remove text from Section 1.0, paragraph 3, regarding providing cost and performance information in Simple Model and Integrated Sampling Model DPFRs. SRS also took this opportunity to review and revise the protocol to reflect the current process and make editorial changes. These changes are summarized below.

- The document revision number, document date, and list of abbreviations and acronyms were updated and grammatical and typographical errors were corrected.
- Sections 1.0 and 3.0 were revised to clarify that the Core Team can agree to forgo development of a Facility Decommissioning Evaluation (FDE) when additional information is not needed to support the use of a CERCLA action for a particular facility decommissioning project (e.g., Building 235-F).
- Sections 3.0, 4.0, 5.0, and 7.0 were revised to correct the title of Federal Facility Agreement (FFA) Appendix K.2.
- Sections 3.0, 5.0, 6.0, 7.0, and Figure 1 were revised to clarify that the DPFR transmittal memo, not the FDE transmittal memo, will include the SRS recommendation as to the administrative path for decommissioned facility/facility remnants to either FFA Appendix C.4 or Appendix K.2.
- Section 7.0 was revised to clarify the process to reach agreement on a Revision 1 DPFR.
- Table 1 was revised to reflect that USEPA now receives electronic submittals rather than hard copies or CDs.

Please review the revised protocol with the goal of responding via email within thirty (30) calendar days with your concurrence or comments.
