Jennifer and Heather,

Per regulatory agreement, the Savannah River Site is notifying the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency and the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control that the ABRP OU active SVE system has been inoperable for more than seven (7) consecutive days. This e-mail serves as notification that the ABRP OU active SVE system has been out of service since November 7, 2017. The unit is experiencing mechanical problems that are causing it to shut down. Maintenance personnel are troubleshooting the ABRP OU active SVE system to determine what repairs are required. A follow-up e-mail will be sent to notify you when this system resumes operation.
